### **Alvin High School Principal named Executive Director of Secondary Education**



The Alvin ISD Board of Trustees approved the recommendation from Interim Superintendent Tommy King to appoint Kevon Wells, Alvin High School Principal as Executive Director of Secondary Education. Wells replaces Carla Voelkel who took a position in another school district.

Kevon Wells has been principal of Alvin High School for the past eight years. Prior to coming to Alvin, he served as principal in West Columbia ISD and Brenham ISD. He also served as assistant principal in La Marque ISD, as an adjunct instructor at College of the Mainland, and as a teacher in Texas City ISD and Galveston ISD.

Wells earned his Bachelor of Science degree in Marine Biology from Texas A&M University and his Master of Secondary Education from the University of Houston at Clear Lake. He has been in the education field for more than twenty-nine years. He holds certification in Physical Education, Provisional Secondary Science

Composite, Professional Mid-Management Administrator, and ESL Supplement. He also holds the Standard Superintendent Certification.

Wells will supervise principals of the secondary campuses and provide supervision to Advanced Academics (Pre-AP), Dual Credit, Dual Degree, Academic Decathlon, and the Gifted and Talented program. He will also supervise the secondary counselors (7-12) and mentor assistant principals.

“I am excited about this new opportunity and am ready to get started,” said Wells.

“We are pleased with the work, commitment and dedication of Mr. Wells, and look forward to his contributions in this new leadership capacity,” said Tommy King, Interim Superintendent.
