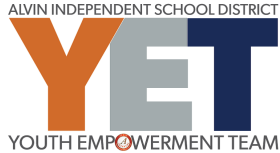

Third year

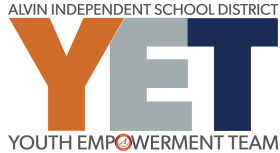

- Attend training (Summer/ 3 hours/ Time and Location TBD) with our YET Mentor Trainers before working with any students.
- Once mentors and mentees are matched, each mentor will meet with their mentee on the school campus, once a week for 30 minutes for the rest of the school year
