2018 – 2019 TARDY POLICY**

At Alvin High School, we expect all students to show up on time, ready to participate and learn. Students are expected to plan their time effectively, so they may arrive to school and classes in a timely manner. We believe our class instructional time is limited and of great value to our students. Therefore, we are implementing a tardy policy which supports and reinforces this belief.

Any student who arrives to class after the tardy bell, and without a pass from a staff member, will be considered tardy. Students who have a class in the vocational building are given an extra minute before and after class.

7 th Period	2:00-2:50	(50)

Tardies will be counted for 3 week periods of time and then start over. Each time a student is tardy, the student is required to get a pass to be admitted into class, and at that time parents will be notified of the tardy through email or a phone call. Any student with six or more tardies in a 3 week period of time will receive the following disciplinary actions:

6 tardies	Power Hour Detention from 11:58 – 12:43 p.m. on the date printed on the tardy slip.
7 tardies	Power Hour Detention from 11:58 – 12:43 p.m. on the dates printed on the tardy slip.
8 tardies	Power Hour Detention from 11:58 – 12:43 p.m. on the dates printed on the tardy slip and a Parent Intervention Conference with parent will be required.
9+ tardies	Students who get more than 9+ tardies in a 3 week periods of time will receive escalating discipline including after school detention, SAC, ISS, and parent notifications.
