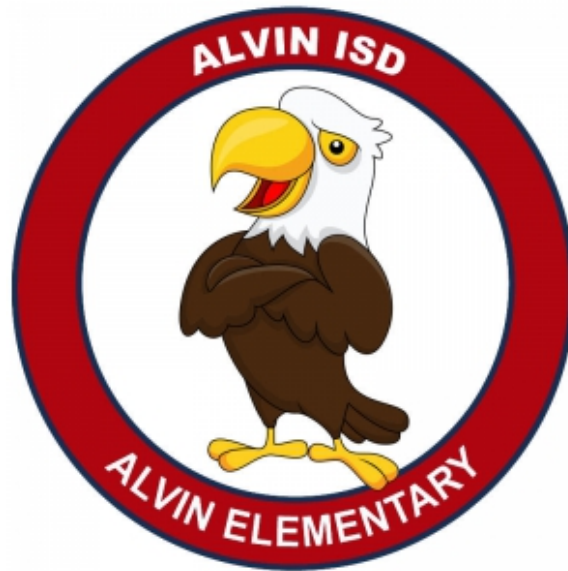

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Goal 1: Academic Performance: Student academic performance will reflect continuous improvement and excellence to achieve profound student learning.

Performance Objective 1: Alvin Elementary will meet or exceed state averages on the STAAR reading, math, writing, and science assessments.

Performance Objective 2: Alvin Elementary will increase the Domain 2 score for school progress.

Performance Objective 3: Alvin Elementary will increase the Domain 3 score for closing gaps.

Performance Objective 4: Alvin Elementary will have a minimum of 60% of students progressing at least one level on TELPAS.

Performance Objective 5: Alvin Elementary will have a minimum of 85% of students meeting or exceeding RIT score goals on the Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) Assessments.

Goal 2: Parental/Community Involvement: Alvin ISD will effectively communicate and will actively engage with parents and the district communities in the education process of our students

Performance Objective 1: 90% of parents will report that their child makes connections to other areas of learning through real-world examples and experiences.

Performance Objective 2: 90% of parents will report that Alvin Elementary does a good job keeping them informed about district and campus activities.

Performance Objective 3: 90% of parents will report that they are provided information about their child's academic strength and areas that need improvement.

Performance Objective 4: 90% of parents will report that Alvin Elementary provides sufficient opportunities for parents to be involved at the school.

Goal 3: Teachers and Staff: Alvin ISD will attract and retain the highest quality teachers and staff and support their efforts with quality professional development.

Performance Objective 1: 95% of staff will report that decisions are made in alignment with the campus core beliefs.

Performance Objective 2: 90% of staff will report that there is good communication between campus administrators and staff members.

Performance Objective 3: 90% of staff will report feeling satisfied with the level of appropriateness of discipline at Alvin Elementary.

Performance Objective 4: 90% of staff will report that staff members connect well with students.

Goal 4: Technology: Alvin ISD will continue to invest in evolving technology which will result in profound student learning.
