

Resolution to Initiate the Process of Designation as a District of Innovation

WHEREAS, the Alvin Independent School District (ISD) Board of Trustees is committed to the excellence of each student and every program; and,

WHEREAS, House Bill 1842 enacted by the 84th Legislature provides Texas public school districts the opportunity to be designated as Districts of Innovation; and,

WHEREAS, the Alvin ISD Board of Trustees wishes to support innovation for the benefit of our students and our community; and,

WHEREAS, Texas Education Code, Chapter 12A, enacted by HB 1842, requires districts seeking to be designated as Districts of Innovation to develop a local innovation plan; and


WHEREAS, the Alvin ISD Board of Trustees believes that any local innovation plan should be developed in collaboration with the community and District stakeholders; and

WHEREAS, before considering creation of a local innovation plan, the Alvin ISD Board of Trustees will hold a public hearing to receive feedback from District stakeholders.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Alvin ISD Board of Trustees on December 13, 2016, initiates the process of exploring and considering designation of the District as a District of Innovation under Texas Education Code, Chapter 12A.
