1) Strategically Collaborates & Communicates

Statement: The future ready learner is a strategic communicator, who understands the importance of and can demonstrate effective communication in a variety of contexts. The learner effectively communicates orally, in writing, and nonverbally; while embracing the role of effective communication in learning, collaboration, sharing, and leading.

Examples:

- The learner will routinely practice oral communication through presentations and collaboration with peers and teachers.
- The learner will use written communication to relay information, articulate and explain his or her point of view, and will be proficient in multiple writing styles.
- The learner will acquire and demonstrate the nonverbal skills necessary to communicate effectively, including the importance of listening, body language, and eye contact when collaborating with peers or interacting with adults.
- The learner will strategically adapt their communication style to a specific audience.

2) Initiates

Statement: The future ready learner assesses problems, develops solutions, and acts to achieve results.

Examples:

- The learner will expand learning opportunities by identifying areas of personal interest, and solving problems related to the content.
- The learner will seek opportunities to solve community-based problems through their coursework.
- The learner will take leadership roles in extra-curricular activities.
- The learner will get involved in the community.

3) Innovates

Statement: The future ready learner develops innovative ideas by expanding the boundaries of creativity.

Examples:

- The learner will create innovative ideas that will be used to generate solutions with a global perspective while impacting the local community.
- The learner will develop innovative ideas to be implemented in collaboration with peers and teachers.

4) Problem Solves, Analyzes Data, and Thinks Critically

Statement: The future ready learner is inquisitive, asks critical questions, collects and evaluates data in order to improve learning and apply knowledge.

Examples:

- The learner will demonstrate the ability to apply learning in real-life scenarios, and will be evaluated by a panel of peers, teachers and industry experts.
- The learner will explore topics of applied science or technology beginning in junior high.
- The learner will apply inquiry skills in various interactive labs at each grade level.
- The learner will apply mathematical skills across multiple disciplines and subjects.
- The learner will routinely identify and evaluate personal shortcomings for the purpose of individual growth and enhancement.

5) Adapts

Statement: The future ready learner is aware that the world is changing at a fast pace. The learner recognizes the necessity to innovate and adapt to various settings while becoming college and/or career ready.

Examples:

- The learner will acclimate to changing roles and responsibilities.
- The learner will respect the views, opinions, and thoughts of others.
- The learner will adapt to real world situations and be prepared to increase efficiency, increase profitability, and reinvent or refine products and processes.
- The learner will adapt to various time constraints.
- The learner will produce a variety of projects that are challenge based, meaningful, and relevant.
- The learner will present real-world projects to a variety of audiences.

6) Empathizes

Statement: The future ready learner is empathetic, and exhibits qualities such as compassion and open-mindedness. The learner values the feelings, thoughts, differences, and experiences of others.

Examples:

- The learner will participate in community outreach programs, which will provide the opportunity to understand the experiences and feelings of others.
- The learner will participate in discussions that require them to consider opposing views, while withholding judgment. The learner will then be provided structured learning opportunities to defend the opposing viewpoint.

7) Values Ethics

Statement: The future ready learner is ethically minded, and demonstrates qualities such as honesty, integrity, and respectfulness.

Examples:

- The learner will model respect for others.
- The learner will demonstrate good moral judgment based on the principles of honesty and personal integrity.
- The learner will adhere to and uphold learner-developed codes of ethics and social contracts.

8) Thinks Globally

Statement: The future ready learner is prepared for a global workforce. The learner has respect for various cultures and appreciates linguistic diversity. The learner explores various career options without the limitations of a language barrier.

Examples:

- The learner will participate in cultural awareness education.
- The learner has the opportunity to participate in bilingual classes beginning in elementary.
- The learner will be provided access to web-based resources to supplement classroom learning.
