

Parent Acknowledgement and Receipt of
AISD PEP Child Care Center
Program Information and Policies

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- I am aware that I may review and discuss with the director, or assistant director, any questions or concerns regarding the center’s policies and procedures.
- I am aware a copy of the Texas DFPS Minimum Standards, and that the center’s most recent licensing inspection report is available for review at the center or online at www.dfps.state.tx.us/ .
- I am aware that I may contact the local Licensing office at 713-940-3009 or online at www.dfps.state.tx.us/, or access the TDFPS child abuse hotline at 1-800-252-5400, regarding *any* concerns or questions. Abuse resource information is also available from the center’s director, upon request. I also understand the AISD’s child care center staff are *required*, by law, to report *any* evidence of neglect or abuse.
- I am aware that communication regarding my child will be provided through daily oral and written contact with caregivers or director, posted activity and lesson plans in the classroom and visually through routine postings located on the center’s **Parent Information Board**.
- I acknowledge that I, the parent, have reviewed a copy of the AISD’s *PEP Child Care Center Parent Handbook*, containing the center’s operational policies and information.
- I am aware that I, the parent, am encouraged and welcome to find *meaningful* ways to participate in my child’s daily experiences and to observe the child care center’s operation without securing prior approval.
- I am aware that under the Texas Penal Code any area within 1000 feet of a child care center is a **gang-free zone** where criminal offenses related to organized criminal activity are subject to a harsher penalty of law.
- *If applicable*, I acknowledge that I, as a student participating in the Alvin ISD’s Pregnancy Education and Parenting Program (PEPP), will meet all criteria and responsibilities required to maintain my child’s place at AISD PEP Child Care Center.
- I confirm that I, the parent, have received information regarding AISD’s PEP Child Care Center’s emergency preparedness plan which describes all center emergency procedures and policies, *e.g.*, designated evacuation locations, communication with families and school/local authorities, emergency care, and accountability steps taken by staff, for children in care, during an emergency situation.
- TDFPS CCL Minimum Standard 746.1203 prohibits the personal use of cell phones in the child care classroom.
