What Are We Learning:

Phonological Awareness: Review of rhyming, beginning sounds, syllables, and words in a sentence.

Phonics: I can spell high frequency words

Reading: I can use illustrations and texts the student is able to read or hear to learn or clarify word meanings.

I can interact with sources in meaningful ways such as illustrating or writing.

Writing: I can plan and generate ideas for fiction writing.

Math: I can identify U.S. coins by name, including pennies, nickels, dimes, and quarters.

Science: I can observe and record properties of objects, including bigger or smaller, heavier or lighter, shape, color, and texture.

I can observe, record, and discuss how materials can be changed by heating or cooling.

Social Studies: I can identify basic landforms and bodies of water.
