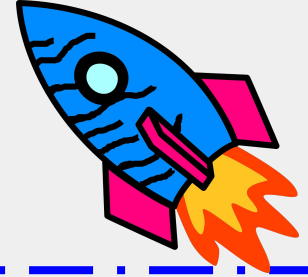
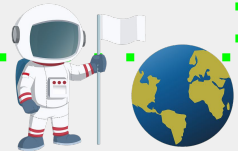

(Read Every Day) Reading Homework Folder with a reader's response sheet for your child to turn in on Fridays. R.E.D. Folders go home daily. Each night (Monday through Thursday) your child is to read a library book for 20-30 minutes and write a written response, utilizing their Reading Reference Sheet to assist them.
