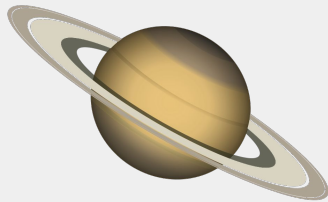

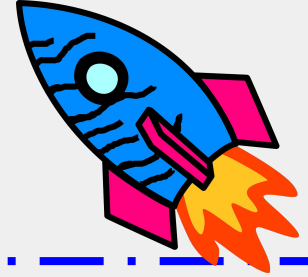
Announcements

R.E.D. Homework must be signed and completed by Friday. Students will complete the reader's response on the backside of homework, as well.



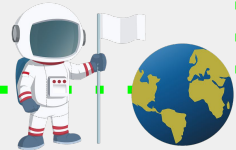

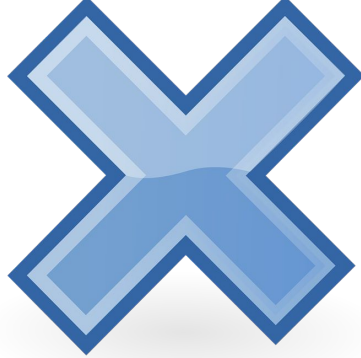
