Infectious Disease

COVID, ETC.

- All students should do a self-screening daily prior to coming to school.
- All students must practice hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette.
- All students should regularly wash their hands throughout the school day.
- If a student is symptomatic while at school, he or she will be evaluated by the school nurse and the student will be required to wear a mask while in the clinic.
- The nurse will evaluate based on the number and severity of symptoms, known exposure and vaccination status.
- If a student is confirmed positive for COVID-19, the campus nurse will coordinate with the parent on the date of symptom onset, symptoms, vaccination status, etc. Students will be excluded from school until 5 days after symptom onset as long as the student is fever free and symptoms are improving. The student will be highly encouraged to wear a mask after returning to school.
- Consistent with school notification requirements for other communicable diseases, and consistent with legal confidentiality requirements, the District will notify the Brazoria County Health Department of all lab-confirmed COVID-19 cases on a weekly basis.
