Alvin Independent School District is committed to the highest possible standards of ethical, moral and legal business conduct. In line with this commitment, the District has established an anonymous reporting hotline. The hotline is intended to be used by employees and citizens to report serious concerns or questionable actions by District employees, vendors, contractors, etc. that:

- May lead to incorrect financial reporting
- Are unlawful
- Are not in line with Alvin ISD policies and procedures
- Otherwise amount to serious improper conduct

Informants Rights: Informants can remain anonymous. The Alvin ISD “Whistleblower” policy (DG-Legal) protects informants who report alleged wrongdoing or acts of fraud from retaliation by the Board or any District employee.

How it works: District employees or citizens can call the hotline 24 hours a day / 7 days a week. Messages can be left during non-business hours. You may remain anonymous by not disclosing your name or you can ask that your identity be kept confidential. If you remain anonymous, please provide as much information as possible to perform an investigation (i.e. name of person(s) involved, date(s), time(s), etc.)

All calls to the Alvin ISD Reporting Hotline should be made in good faith to report fraud, waste or abuse rather than a means for malicious allegations or to report general dissatisfaction with supervisors or job duties. Personnel grievances (salaries, discrimination, etc.) should be reported in accordance with board policy DGBA(local).
